

## What is Behaviour Analysis?

- 1. Behaviour analysis focuses on adapting environmental contingencies to promote positive outcomes.
- 2. Focus on 'socially significant' goals (focus on person-centred, consent-based approaches).
- 3. Meaningful improvement in important behaviour (like learning or communicating).
- 4. Analyse the factors responsible for improvement.
- 5. Methods are described and implemented in a clear, systematic manner.


### Work Experience/Employment
