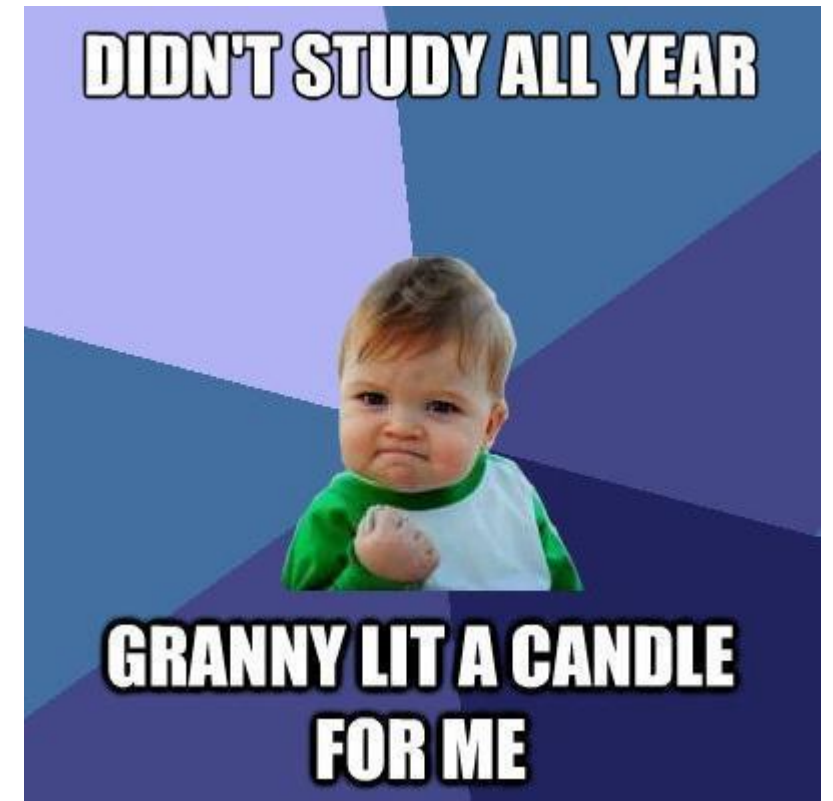

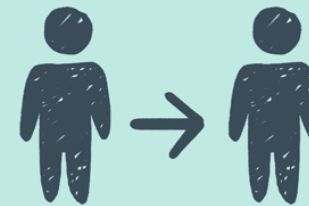
A DAY IN THE LIFE OF A PSYCHOLOGIST

Make referrals to outside therapists, clinics, & treatment facilities

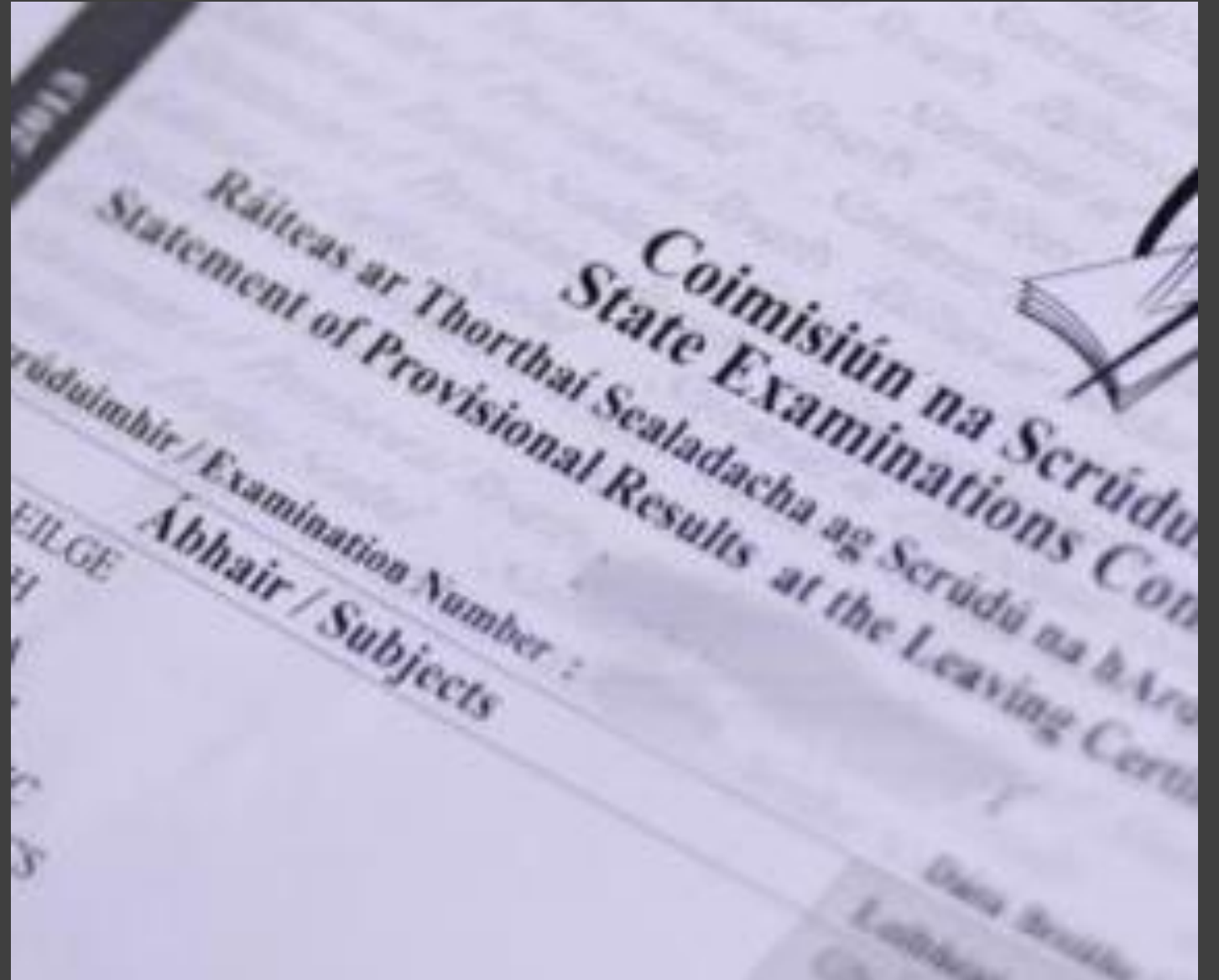

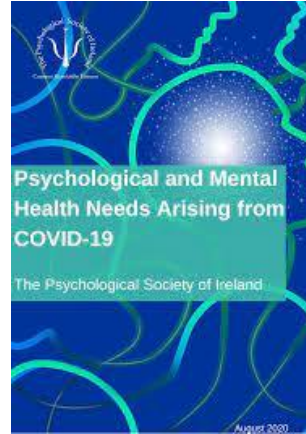
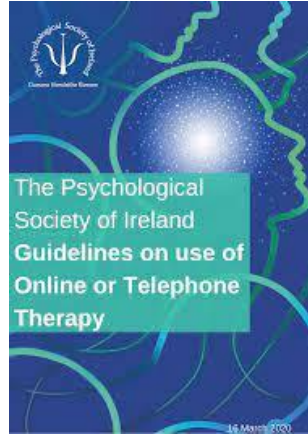
