



National Integrated Care Programme for Older Persons Rehabilitation Framework for Older People Nomination Form

Purpose of the Group

The National Integrated Care Programme for Older Persons is establishing a Working Group to agree and develop an overall strategy for a rehabilitation framework for Older People in Ireland.

The aim of the working group will be to publish a Rehabilitation Framework for Older People in Ireland, defining governance, care settings, service models, staffing levels and outcomes.

Chair & Frequency of Meetings:

This group will be chaired by Dr. Emer Ahern, National Clinical Lead, Unscheduled Care Older Persons.

The group will commence in early May and will aim to complete the strategy by the 30th November. Meetings will be held fortnightly online. The current proposed time is Monday, 4-5pm however this is subject to change.

There will be a requirement to complete additional work outside of these meetings to progress the development of this Framework.

Role of the HSCP reps:

Two HSCP representatives are being sought for this working group.

HSCP disciplines identified in the *Specialist Geriatric Services Model of Care* as core MDT members in the provision of rehabilitation include Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language Therapy, Medical Social Workers, Psychology and Dietetics. Nominations are therefore sought from one of these disciplines. The two HSCP representatives will be representing the role of HSCPs in the provision of rehabilitation services to Older Persons across a variety of settings, and will work closely with the HSCP Clinical Advisor for Older Persons who will also be a member of the working group.

The existing HSCP Older Persons Advisory Group was established to ensure engagement and consultation between NICPOP and the HSCP representatives. The HSCP reps will engage with and liaise closely with the HSCP Older Persons Advisory Group to progress the development of the National Integrated Care Programme for Older Persons Rehabilitation Framework.
