Purpose of the Group

The HSE has provided funding for National Clinical Guideline No. 21 (“Appropriate prescribing of psychotropic medication for non-cognitive symptoms in people with dementia”) to be implemented over a two year period by a project implementation team through the National Dementia Office. The primary aim of the programme is to implement the guideline on a phased basis across settings, in acute care, residential care, and within community settings. In addition, the project also aims to evaluate the impact of the implementation of the guideline. A national Steering Committee is being convened to oversee this programme of work.

Chair & Frequency of Meetings:

The Steering Committee is Co-Chaired by Ms Janette Dwyer, Assistant National Director, Services for Older People, Change & Innovation, and the Clinical Lead for the National Dementia Office (when in post).

Approximately three meetings of the Steering Committee will be held per year for the duration of the programme. The proposed schedule of meetings is as follows:

- 2022: March, June, and October
- 2023: February, June, and October

Meetings will be held virtually in the first instance, and may be held in-person over time. The expected duration of meetings is 90-120 minutes.

Role of the HSCP lead rep:

- Understand the goals, objectives and desired outcomes of the project
- Understand and represent the interests of project stakeholders and facilitate knowledge transfer and exchange between the project group and stakeholders.
- Actively participate in meetings through attendance, discussion, and review of minutes, papers and other Steering Committee documents.
- Attend meetings as required and actively participate in the Steering Committee’s work.
